

## 2010 BSA INTERNATIONAL POST RALLY RUN

The post rally South Island run commences on Monday the 15th February 2010. The tour cost is priced on Cabin accommodation (sleep 4-5) and includes Continental breakfasts. Cost - \$300 per person approx. Extra cost if upgrade in accommodation is required ie share twin. A backup vehicle will accompany the group. We will also hire an 11 seater van if enough interest is shown for non riders and that cost will be approx \$15 per head per day over and above the accommoda-

tion cost.

**Please book early as accommodation in February 2010 is at a premium.**

Itinerary is as follows:-

- Day 1 Christchurch - Greymouth 242km (3hrs 30mins)
- Day 2 Greymouth - Westport - Greymouth 102kms (1hr 30min) each way
- Day 3 Greymouth - Fox Glacier 196km (3hrs)
- Day 4 Fox Glacier - Wanaka 262km (3hrs 30mins)
- Day 5 Wanaka - Queenstown 67km (1hr)
- Day 6 Queenstown
- Day 7 Queenstown - Omarama 170km (2hrs 30mins)
- Day 8 Omarama - Christchurch 313km (4hrs 30mins)
