

Invitation to the 47th International BSA Rally

Christchurch New Zealand

Hosted by Canterbury BSA Owners Club Incorporated

7 - 13 February 2010

The Canterbury BSA Owners Club kindly invites all members and their BSAs to participate in the 47th BSA International Rally. Of course, your partner and children are most welcome.

The Rally will take place at the Canterbury University, Corner of Ilam and Maidstone Roads, Christchurch. Because the venue is built for students, accommodation is in single rooms, with a limited number of twin rooms available. These twin rooms will be allocated to married (partners) couples, at the Rally Committee's discretion.

In case you want to come several days earlier and need a place to stay, the University will accept people to stay a couple of nights before the start of the rally. Please advise if required. Payment is to be made to the University on arrival.

A catering group has been hired, which is more than capable of preparing 550 meals per day. Breakfast will be continental; lunch will be boxed and taken with us on the runs, due to some of the places which we will visit not having facilities capable of feeding 200 people. Dinner will be a buffet type meal, apart from the gala dinner, which will be table service. Please advise if any special meals are required, e.g. vegetarian.

The rally fee is due by every participant (also for partners, passenger/kids). Children under 5 years are free, and for children under 12 years a reduced fee applies. The rally fee implicates the costs of participation on several activities. Rally Fees are non refundable.

BSA Owners' Club International Rules

1. The rally shall be known as "The BSA Owners Club 47th International Rally"
2. The rally shall be open to all members (and their families) of a BSA Club as recognised by them in their members list
3. All participants will be expected to participate with a BSA motorcycle.
4. Any person wishing to attend without a BSA motorcycle may do so only if they have permission from the organizing committee.
5. All other vehicles, including trailers, brought onto the rally site must be stored so that they not interfere with any site activities.
6. All participants will behave in a reasonable manner and will comply with all reasonable requests to moderate behaviour or to comply with any Health and Safety requirements.
7. Any rules or Health and Safety requirements set out by the University will be considered rules of the rally
8. The Rally Committee reserves the right to refuse admission and to deal with misbehaviour as it sees fit and will enforce these rules according to its interpretation of them.
9. Day visitors will be charged a rally fee and will be subject to all rules and restrictions. Day visitors must report to Rally Control o
10. If a participant cancels his or her registration more than ninety (90) days before the commencement date of the rally, the registration fee paid will be refunded, less a sum representing administration costs. If a participant cancels his or her registration between ninety (90) and thirty (30) days before the commencement date of the rally, the refund will be 50% of the registration fee. If a participant cancels his or her registration thirty (30) days or less before the commencement date of the rally, there will be no refund made of the registration fee.
11. In the event of the Rally being cancelled (Swine Flu or Act of God); the Rally Committee will refund the registration fee, less a sum representing administration costs.
12. The Canterbury BSAOC will not be responsible for any loss, injury, damage or any consequential loss suffered by a participant or any third party during the course of the rally. Including due to a negligent act or omission by the Canterbury BSAOC.
13. Participants shall be responsible for their own visas, licences, motorcycles, vehicle registrations, warrants of fitness, insurance and the like.
